

**COUNTRYSIDE & RIGHTS OF WAY ACT 2000, COMMONS ACT 2006
CLEAN NEIGHBOURHOODS & ENVIRONMENT ACT 2005, DOG CONTROL ORDER 2006**

**REGULATIONS ON THE USAGE OF COMMONS IN THE PARISH OF BROUGHTON GIFFORD
To include Broughton Common, Norrington Common and Norrington Green**

The above Commons are specifically designated within Schedule 2 of the Fouling of Land by Dogs Order 2012 and it is an offence to allow your dog to foul and not clean up afterwards.

Maximum Fine £1,000 or £75 Instant Fixed Penalty Notice

PLEASE TAKE NOTE THAT IT IS A CRIMINAL OFFENCE to carry out the following activities on any of the above Commons without proper authority:

- Drive or ride any vehicles
- Light or tend fires
- Use a metal detector
- Remove or damage any plant, shrub, tree or root
- Interfere with any fence, barrier, or other device designed to prevent accidents or to enclose livestock
- Display or affix any advertisement, bill, placard or notice
- Engage in any activity that is organised or undertaken for any commercial purpose
- Engage in any unauthorised agricultural activity or encroachment

Any person(s) breaching these rules will have committed an OFFENCE and, if convicted, may be liable to a fine of up to £2,500.

Broughton Gifford Parish Council has also approved the following regulations:-

- Horse-riding will be permitted on the commons, provided that:-
 - a. Riding does not endanger or annoy other persons using the commons
 - b. Riding is occasional and does not damage natural pathways and sport pitches
- No person shall erect or use a tent, marquee, caravan or motor home on the commons without Parish Council consent.
- No person shall turn out or permit any animal to graze on the commons, unless authorised by statute or by the Parish Council.
